THE EXECUTIVE REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE FINANCIAL SUPPORT PROVIDED TO RESEARCH GROUPS AND PROJECTS

2020

INTRODUCTION

The Deanship of Scientific Research seeks to support and enable researchers to obtain their funded research opportunities, and that is through the financial support provided by the Deanship for groups and research projects. In this introduction, the most prominent the terms used in this framework as a first article, followed by the executive regulations governing financial support.

Clause 1: Terms and definitions

Based on the Unified Regulations for Scientific Research in Saudi Universities; these terms are mentioned in relation to their close relationship with scientific research as follows:

- **The Scientific Search:**

It is an achievement that is based on the scientific foundations known to it in the scientific research community, and is the result of individual efforts. or joint efforts, or both.

- **The Research Group**

A number of researchers have purchased similar specializations or disparities in practical work and scholarly work in one scientific achievement.

- **The Principal Investigator**

He is the member of the teaching staff, or the like, who represents the group participating in the research and is in charge of supervising and managing the group.

- **The Associate Researcher**

He is a member of the teaching staff or equivalent, who is partnering with a group of researchers to study the topic.

- **The Examiner Arbitrator**

He is a member of the faculty or expert assigned to examine and study scientific production.

- **The Reference**

He is a member of the faculty or equivalent, or the expert assigned to review scientific production.

- **The Advisor**

He is a member of the faculty or an equivalent person, or the expert assigned to a research center specialized in providing services or studies.

▪ **The Scientific paper**

It is the scientific proof of the publishing's eligibility in the contents of the paper in terms of facts, methods, findings and recommendations published in scientific periodicals specialized international standards subject to leather standards for scientific publication.

▪ **Global Classification Rules**

They are the rules for listing, organizing and arranging research publications, and sorting them according to specialization and the quality of publication and authorship to ensure that specialized quality is of high quality.

▪ **The University's Research Priorities**

It is a set of scientific and literary axes that are updated annually, hence the financial support for research for this year was allocated, and these are the firsts without others.

The Financial Support

It is the financial value approved for conducting a research or research group that has been passed over for scientific judgment and is consistent with research priorities for the university.

Clause 2: Funding Programs

The funding and financial support in the scientific research column are given to the standards contained in this regulation and the organization of the research, technical and financial relationship between the Deanship and the researchers supported from within the University through the different Deans Funding Programs statements as follows:

- The Research Groups.
- Da'em Program.
- The Institutional Financing.
- The Individual projects.
- The New funding programs that take place after the issuance of these regulations.

Clause 3

The Scientific Committee is concerned with the Deanship of Scientific Research and affiliated with the Agency for Higher Studies and Scientific Research at the University to apply the regulations set forth in this by law, whereby a committee is formed annually by a decision of happiness during the period of scientific research, provided that were assigned to the committee by the Excellency of the Dean of Scientific Research and on behalf of the faculty members who have adequate

research experience and administrative technician; to decide on the topics submitted to the committee.

Clause 4

The scientific paper is not accepted and is not considered among the research outputs required of research groups or individual projects, if the researcher publishes the scientific paper of the research group or individual scientific projects in periodic journals not listed in the CCPs' scientific publishing rules.

Clause 5

Scientific papers presented in research groups or individual humanitarian projects published in scientific periodical publication not included in the approved scientific publishing rules and clear in the issued policies and procedures guide by the Deanship of Scientific Research is not accepted.

Clause 6

Not accepted the scientific papers submitted by the principal investigator of the research groups or the researcher in projects individual or Da'em projects except in the event that a full account appears on the scientific publication data sites.

Clause 7

Scientific papers published or accepted for publication by the principal investigator for research groups, individual projects or Da'em projects are not accepted if the publishing language that differs from the main language declared in the priorities of scientific research for each stage.

Clause 8:

A scientific paper published or accepted for publication by the principal investigator shall not be accepted in all funded research programs if the researcher does not mention his affiliation to the employees of Taif University in the publication information, provided that the address of Taif University is the only address mentioned for the researcher published in the scientific paper, whether for the main researcher or for all participants from the members of the research group mentioned in the contract.

Clause 9

Scientific paper published or accepted for publication by the principal investigator of research groups, individual projects or Da'em projects is not accepted if the publisher ignores the mention of the thanks for the university in the place specified for it in the scientific paper and give the researcher a three months opportunity to

correct this error. In the event of the inability to remedy this error, he shall object for a deduction of 20% of the total contracted financing. In the event, the researcher mentioned the thank you for the university without mentioning the funding number, he shall object for a deduction of 20% of the total contracted financing and must submit a declaration that this paper has not been submitted as part of the publication award programs.

Clause 10

A scientific paper published or accepted for publication by the principal investigator of the research groups, individual projects or Da'em projects is not accepted in the event that the scientific paper is sent to the journal or accepted or was published on a previous date of the contract signed between the deanship and the principal investigator.

Clause 11

Scientific papers published or accepted for publication by the principal investigator of the research groups, individual projects or Da'em projects are not accepted if the title, topic, or overall content of the scientific paper presented differs or with the title, topic and the content of the research group contracted with the principal investigator, unless prior written approval is obtained from the Deanship of Scientific Research.

Clause 12

Scientific papers published or accepted for publication by the principal investigator of the research groups, individual projects or Da'em projects are not accepted if the title of the submitted scientific paper and the scientific content of the scientific paper differ with the research priority contracted with the principal investigator.

Clause 11

Scientific papers published or accepted for publication by the principal investigator of the research groups, individual projects or Da'em projects are not accepted if the title, topic, or overall content of the scientific paper presented differs or with the title, topic and the content of the research group contracted with the principal investigator, unless prior written approval is obtained from the Deanship of Scientific Research.

Clause 12

Scientific papers published or accepted for publication by the principal investigator of the research groups, individual projects or Da'em projects are not accepted if the title of the submitted scientific paper and the scientific content of the scientific paper differ with the research priority contracted with the principal investigator.

Clause 13

The scientific paper published or accepted for publication by the principal investigator of the research groups is not accepted if it is not included all names of researchers included in the contract between the Deanship of Scientific Research and the principal investigator, scientifically that researchers can be added from outside the group.

Clause 14

A scientific paper published or accepted for publication is not accepted by the principal investigator of the research groups if the first publisher for the scientific paper is not from Taif University employees.

Clause 15

In the event that the principal investigator is unable to complete the supervision of the research group, the responsibility is displayed to the participating researchers from the research group, and in case one of them does not agree, to represent the group as a principal investigator The decision to freeze the group will be implemented with a study of what has been submitted, provided that the decision requires to return what was spent off financial support in the event that no research papers are submitted according to the applicable standards or that what has been declared is sufficient in the event of submission scientific papers subject to applicable standards.

Clause 16

In the event that the principal investigator - for research groups, individual projects or Da'em projects wishes to close the funding after publishing all scientific papers according to the conditions and standards regulated and the researcher expresses his desire to change or amend an item of the budget. The request is rejected, and the principal investigator is given a one-month period to amend the budget.

Clause 17

In the event that the principal investigator of the research groups, individual projects or Da'em projects submits the final report, his desire to close the funding after publishing all scientific papers according to the criteria regulating for this, and the researcher had purchased a device conditional on his submission to the administration of the central laboratories of the Deanship after its completion, and he did not do so. The president will deduct the equipment fee in full.

Clause 18

The Scientific Committee at the Deanship of Scientific Research has the authority to grant exceptions regarding the previous clauses in some special and emergency cases and as required by the interest of the deanship or researcher, taking into account justice and equality of penalties and procedures in similar cases.

Clause 19

The bylaw and new developments therein shall be submitted to the Council of the Deanship of Scientific Research for approval and approval.

Clause 20

This material includes the applicable funding and support programs and the terms of the research outputs for each funding program, as follows:

The rules governing the publication of research papers in the Arabic language:

- 1- The journal should be issued by an educational institution.
- 2- That the title of the journal clearly indicates its content.
- 3- That the magazine has issued at least four issues and that at least two years have passed since its first issue.
- 4- That the magazine was published regularly without interruption during the last three years.
- 5- The journal must be internationally registered and have an international depository number. ISSN
- 6- That the magazine has published rules and regulations.
- 7- The journal should have an editorial board and arbitration board with expertise in scientific research in the journal's field of specialization.
- 8- For the magazine to use contemporary methods and information technology in communicating with researchers and arbitrators, and to have a website that enables researchers to access complete research through textual searches by electronic search engines.
